Takes 1 skein of white, 1 of yellow, and 1 of black Starting with yellow yarn

- 1. Sc 6 in magic ring (6)
- 2. Inc around (12)
- 3. [ Sc. Inc ] around (18)
- 4. [ Sc 2, Inc ] around (24)
- 5. [ Sc 3, Inc ] around (30)
- 6. [ Sc ] around (30)

Change to black yarn

7-8. [ Sc ] around (30)

Change to yellow yarn

9-10. [ Sc ] around (30)

Change to black yarn

11-12. [ Sc ] around (30)

Change to yellow yarn

13-14. [ Sc ] around (30)

Change to black yarn

15-16. [ Sc ] around (30)

Change to yellow yarn

17. [ Sc 3, Dec ] around (24)

18. [ Sc 2, Dec ] around (18)

19. [ Sc, Dec ] around (12)

20. [ Dec ] around (6)

#### Wings of the Bee

1. Sc 7 in the magic ring

2. Inc around (14)

F/O and weave in the ends

Make 2 of them

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### DAISY FLOWER COASTER PATTERN



Takes 2 skein of yarn Begin in yellow

1. Sc 6 in magic ring (6)

2. Inc around (12)

3. [ Sc. Inc ] around (18)

#### Change to white yarn

I highly recommend watching the videos to view how the pedals are created as it may be difficult to visualize how they are created by just reading the pattern.

4. [ Chain 7, Sc 6 down the chain, Sc in the next stitch ] repeat around

5. On each chain work the following (each row is one per stitch)

SI St

SI St

Sc

**HDC** 

Dc

Dc

On the other side of the chain work the following, again its one stich per row

Dc

Dc

**HDC** 

Sc

SI St

SI St

After the pedal is created SL St into the next stitch.

Continue row 5 by creating a pedal and crocheting a SI St after each pedal is formed.

F/O Weave in the end tails.

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### **INFINITY SCARF PATTERN**

Takes about 6 skeins of yarn

Crochet a chain that's approximately 44 inches long.

My chain was about 175 chains long but yours can vary depending on your tension.

Once you have your chain of 44 inches in length, chain an extra 3 chains and turn your work.

Rows 1-4 Skipping the chain 3 Dc across till you get to the end of the chain, chain an extra 3 and turn your work.

After row 4 change to new color Rows 5-8 Skipping the chain 3 Dc across till you get to the end of the chain, chain an extra 3 and turn your work.

After row 8 change to new color Rows 9-12 Skipping the chain 3 Dc across till you get to the end of the chain, chain an extra 3 and turn your work.

F/O and weave in ends

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### **HEADBAND / EAR WARMER PATTERN**



#### Takes about 2 skeins of yarn

Starting in grey yarn Crochet a chain that's approximately 20 inches long. My chain was about 70 chains long but yours can vary depending on your tension.

Once you have your chain of 44 inches in length, chain an extra 3 chains and turn your work.

Rows 1-2. Skipping the chain 3 Dc across till you get to the end of the chain, chain an extra 3, and turn your work.

After row 2 change to new variegated colored

Rows 3-4. Skipping the chain 3 Dc across till you get to the end of the chain, chain an extra 3 and turn your work.

After row 8 change to grey colored yarn Rows 5. Skipping the chain 3 Dc across till you get to the end of the chain, chain an extra 3 and turn your work.

Row 6. Skipping the chain 3 Dc across till you get to the end of the chain, chain an extra 3 and turn your work F/O

Attach both ends together and sew across using a yarn needle

#### Middle piece

Using variegated yarn Chain 7

1-3 DC across, at the end of the row chain 3 and turn

4 DC across, at the end of the row F/O

Sew the middle piece onto the ear warmer


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### STYLISH BAG PATTERN



Crochet a chain that's as long as you would like the bag to be wide across.

Once you have your chain made, chain an extra 3, turn your work continue the pattern below.

HDC across chain an extra 3 chains and turn your work
HDC across chain an extra 3 chains and turn your work
DC across chain an extra 3 chains and turn your work

Repeat the 3-row sequence 5 times, however, if you would like the bag to be bigger you can continue the sequence until you are happy with the bag length.

When you are happy with the bag length cut the yarn and Sc across both sides of the bag.

F/O and weave-in ends

#### **Bag Handle**

Chain the length of the handle that you would like. When you are happy with the length work a row of HDC back into the chain F/O and weave-in ends

#### Beanie Pattern

Takes 4 skeins of yarn

- 1. Create a magic ring, chain 2 and 12 Dc into the magic ring, SI St into the top of the chain 2 (12)
- 2. Chain 2 and [ DC Inc ] around SI St into the top of chain 2 (24)
- 3. Chain 2 and [ Dc, Dc Inc ] around SI St into the top of chain 2 (36)
- 4. Chain 2 and [ Dc, Dc, Dc Inc ] around SI St into the top of the chain 2 (48)
- 5. Chain 2 and [Dc, Dc, Dc, Dc Inc] around SI St into the top of the chain 2 (60)
- 6-11. Chain 2 and [ Dc ] around SI St into the top of chain 2 (36)

F/O and weave-in ends
